The Ministry of Education and Child Care will release funding allocations for the upcoming school year in mid-March. The district will use this information, plus feedback on your general priorities, to prepare a draft budget. On Thursday, April 17, the district will release the draft budget recommendations on its website and in the local media.

Provide feedback on the draft budget recommendations. Details on how to do this will be shared when they are released on April 17.

Following consideration of your feedback on the draft budget recommendations, the budget may change as directed by the Delta Board of Education. The district must submit a final, balanced budget to the Ministry of Education and Child Care by June 30.
